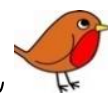




Learning Log Information for this Half Term



Please choose activities from each of the English, Maths and Science rows to work on through the half term. When you have completed these work on some of the other extra activities that have been suggested.

<p>English</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u> ch sh th ng Use the sounds above - with an adult make a list of as many words as you can which have these sounds in. Can you write a sentence with some of these words?</p>	<p><u>Phonics</u> Read these words to an adult and draw on the sound buttons: big frog shell jump chick jam</p>	<p><u>Sentences</u> Draw a seaside picture and write sentences about it.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p><u>Comparing calculation</u> Use < > = to compare the following calculations: 3 + 1 1 + 5 1 + 6 6 + 1 6 - 2 3 + 2 1 + 1 1 - 1 3 + 3 7 - 1 2 + 2 3 + 3</p>	<p><u>Addition and subtraction</u> Solve the following calculations: 4 + 2 = 6 + 3 = 6 + 4 = 4 + 4 = 5 - 2 = 9 - 3 = 6 - 5 =</p>	<p><u>Number game</u> Create your own board game using the numbers 1 - 20. It could be like snakes and ladders.</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p><u>Humans</u> Draw a picture of yourself and label the following parts: Head, neck, arm, hand, leg, foot, elbow, knee and shoulder.</p>	<p><u>Senses</u> There are 5 senses: Sight Smell Touch Hearing Taste Write down 4 things that you can sense for each. E.g. I can hear music, talking, the doorbell and dogs barking.</p>	<p><u>Senses</u> Create an information poster about our 5 senses.</p>
