<p>English</p>	<p>Imagine you have your own aeroplane. If you could fly anywhere in the world where would you go? Can you describe what it is like and draw a picture?</p>	<p>Imagine you are packing a suitcase to fly around the world. Can you decide what would be in your suitcase and describe it? Challenge: Can you present this in an interesting way?</p>	<p>Can you invent your own explorer to join you on your journey? Think about: what they look like, what they wear, what they smell like and their favourite things.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>The amount is £5.12. How many different ways can you make this amount using the different coins?</p>	<p>Can you write your 10 and 5 times tables? Time yourself and see whether you can beat your score. Challenge: Can you beat a family member or friend?</p>	<p>Look around your house to see how many different 2-D shapes you can find. Challenge: Can you count the amount of each shape?</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>Can you create your own cold habitat like the North Pole? You can present this in any way you choose.</p>	<p>Go outside and see what animals you can find. Can you draw the animals and the habitat that they live in?</p>	<p>Can you make a list of some of the most important things in your house that help to keep you alive. Challenge: Can you draw them?</p>
