

## **Pupil Premium Update 2014/2015**

### **Allocation**

Pupil Premium Allocation has allowed staff at Tang Hall Primary School to have a positive impact on the educational and emotional outcomes for all pupils, especially those pupils eligible for Pupil Premium. Following the successful impact that the previous year's spending has had, this is the current update on the spend.

### **Service/Items that Supports Learning –**

These initiatives include, further playground development, interventions for each class through additional support staff time, teacher interventions, management time for tracking and assessing pupils, mentoring, behavioural support, CLA, Safeguarding and interventions for pupils with English as an additional language. The role of the learning mentor, pastoral and educational has been extended to two members of staff. These act as support for pupils and parents. The directive that Pupil Premium children should be provided with milk has meant that some of the allocation has had to be spent on providing this service.

Further ELKLAN training has been paid for to train a member of staff in speech therapy following the departure of the member of staff previously responsible for this service.

**Equipment to Support Learning** - Pupil Premium continues to be used to supply intervention materials. Phonics, Big Maths, resources and training school wide, and Numicon

**Extra-Curricular Support** – Pupils have access to a Breakfast Club which is supported by Pupil Premium money; staffing and resources. This is already attracted many of our pupils and has a positive impact on attendance and punctuality. Children are more ready to learn once the day begins as they are fed. PP Pupils will be able to visit Rock UK residential centre for a second time. This is open to ear 5 pupils this year. There will be the provision of booster support for Year 6, rewards and awards for attainment, school trips (transport costs), one to one tuition teacher costs, pupil attendance and reading challenge reward trip.

**After School Activities** – children continue to be provided with a range of extra curricular activities and Pupils eligible for Pupil Premium are actively encouraged to attend. There is a

cost implication in terms of some staffing requirements and the employment of some outside providers, eg. Fencing, Inkwell
