Thank you so much for your patience and support today. All class teachers have been telephoning families to ensure we offer you the right support during this challenging time. If you have missed the phone call, teachers will try again tomorrow. Please pick up a withheld or unknown number as it is most probably your child's teacher.

We now have a clearer picture of the numbers of vulnerable and key worker children needing access to school and will be finalising our staffing rotas and home learning offer tomorrow.

At Tang Hall, we are determined to have a remote learning offer which directly mirrors the work being offered in school to ensure all of our pupil's gain the same learning and level of support and families can feel confident in following the government's guidelines of stay home and safe lives.

If you have completed the key worker registration form or spoken with your child's class teacher or the pastoral team then we are ready to support your child in school tomorrow. We will support any children who need a school packed lunch (usual costs apply or free to free school meals) but if you can provide a pack up this would be very helpful while we make specific arrangements with our catering team on site. Today and tomorrow, your children have a wide range of activities to complete on their class learning logs which you can supplement with reading and use of our usual free apps and software including Purple Mash and TT Rock Stars. Your children should have their login details within their school planners and can start to upload any work they have completed to Seesaw!

From Thursday, we will go live with our remote learning offer which will include daily online registration for all children (both at home and in school) and a mixture of recorded teaching and high quality resources. All children are expected to complete their learning and this will be closely monitored by school staff. Families will receive further information and instructions about this tomorrow via text message, email, Twitter and on the school website so please watch out for this!
